

G-105 EQUIPMENT USAGE

- A. Any assistive technology equipment having been purchased by East Central to enable a child with a disability to benefit from his/her special designed instructions will remain at the property of the unit until/unless the parent or guardian of the child requests to purchase said equipment. Equipment would remain at the school during summer vacation and in the event the student exits the special education unit by virtue of age, graduation or movement out of the unit.
- B. At the discretion of the director, students may be allowed to take equipment home at night, during vacations, and/or over the summer if the equipment is needed to maintain skills gained during the school year. In the event, the parents or guardians will be required to sign an assistive technology equipment agreement outlining the conditions for usage of the equipment.
